Beverage Policies

Cash Bar

All beverages are paid for by the guests at regular banquet bar pricing at time of purchase.

Host Bar

A host bar must be set up by Catering Department before event. All beverages are charged to the host bar on a per drink bases or by half barrel pricing. Restrictions apply. Beverage estimates are estimates only; the hotel cannot guarantee under any circumstances that the estimate advanced payment will cover the actual host bar beverage cost. All sales are subject to applicable sales tax (5%) and service charge (18%).

Bartender Fee

The bartender fee is **\$15.00 per hour per bartender** with a two hour minimum required.

Beverage Regulations

The sales and serve of alcoholic beverages are regulated by the Wisconsin State Liquor Commission. As a licensee, the Holiday Inn Appleton is responsible for the administration of these regulations. It is our policy; therefore, that liquor cannot be brought into the function rooms of the hotel from outside sources.

Alcohol beverages will be served by a licensed bartender at all functions. Everyone consuming alcoholic beverages must be of legal drinking age. **Holiday Inn Appleton policy forbids the consumption of any alcohol by anyone under 21 years of age regardless of parental consent and requires everyone under the age of 40 to present a valid identification to consume alcohol.**

Banquet, reception, and party hosts anticipating alcoholic beverage service when minors will be attending the function will be required to sign the acknowledgement form of the Wisconsin State law prior to the function.

“Wisconsin law prohibits sales and /or service of alcoholic beverages to anyone under the legal drinking age. Private parties intending to have minors present when alcohol is served must notify law enforcement authorities of the event.”
