<b>30. Merlot, Beringer Founders' Estate (California)</b> Intense aromas of red fruits, cherries, and strawberries; in the palate the wine presents fruity flavors with soft tannins, good balance, and a lingering finish.	\$5.25	\$20.00
<b>31. Merlot, Ravenswood (Sonoma)</b> Rich, full-bodied, with scents of cedar and cherries, and flavors of black fruit and spice.	\$8.25	\$32.00
<b>32. Cabernet Sauvignon, Trapiche Oak Cask (Argentina)</b> Smooth and refined with currant, cherry, and wild berry flavors enhanced by hints of oak.	\$5.50	\$22.00
<b>33. Cabernet Sauvignon, Geyser Peak (Alexander Valley)</b> Generous blackberry fruits that take clove and cinnamon, making this a warm and enticing Cabernet.	\$6.75	\$26.00

<b>21. Chardonnay, Kendall Jackson (California)</b> Forward fruit flavors and aromas of peach, green apple, melon, and tropical fruit layered with butterscotch and oak. Lush and rich yet dry with balanced acidity.	\$8.25	\$32.00
<b>22. Piesporter Michelsburg Spatlese, St. Christina (Germany)</b> This wine is intense in flavor and concentration, but not necessarily sweet. Its crisp citrus flavors match well with richer, more flavorful foods.	\$5.25	\$20.00
<b>23. Pinot Grigio, Placido (Italy)</b> Refreshing, well-balanced, dry, crisp, and fruity with an intense bouquet.	\$5.25	\$20.00
